TO: All unknown birthfathers
1. YOU, and EACH OF YOU, will please take notice that Petitioner has filed a Petition For Adoption and Termination of Parent/Child Relationship in the above entitled Court. Said document pertains to the birth of infant child who was born on September 14, 2014, in Cowlitz County, Washington. The natural Mother of the minor child is Kasie C. Spencer, a resident of Cowlitz County, Washington.

2. A hearing date of March 2, 2016, at 9:00 a.m. has been scheduled. The hearing will occur in the Snohomish County Superior Court, Snohomish County Courthouse, Family Law Department, 3000 Rockefeller Avenue, Everett, Washington. The precise location of the hearing can be determined by requesting said information from the Snohomish County Superior Court Clerk's office, located on the second floor of the Snohomish County Courthouse.

3. The alleged Father is informed and advised as follows, pursuant to RCW 26.33.110:

3.1 He has a right to be represented by legal counsel, and legal counsel will be appointed for an indigent person who requests counsel.

3.2 That the failure of the alleged Father to respond to the termination action within twenty (20) days of service if served within

the State of Washington or thirty (30) days if served outside of the State of Washington will result in the termination of his parent/child relationship, with respect to the above-named minor children.

3.3 That if an alleged Father of an Indian child acknowledges paternity of the child, or if his paternity of the child is established prior to the termination of the parent/child relationship, that his parental rights may not be terminated unless he: (i) Gives valid consent to termination, or (ii) his parent/child relationship is terminated involuntarily pursuant to RCW 26.33 or 13.34.

3.4 The failure to file a paternity claim under RCW 26.26 or to respond to the Petition For Adoption and Termination of Parent/Child Relationship within twenty (20) days of the date of service of the petition is grounds to terminate his parent/child relationship with respect to the abovenamed minor children.

4. The purpose of the hearing will be to terminate the parental rights of the minor child's natural Mother and alleged Father and to approve the pending adoption.

5. At the time and place of said hearing, there may be presented to this Court for entry of the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, and a Decree of Adoption and Order Terminating Parental Rights of Natural Parents.

FAILURE TO APPEAR AT THE HEARING MAY RESULT IN AN ORDER PERMANENTLY TERMINATING YOUR RIGHTS WITH RESPECT TO THE ABOVE-NAMED CHILD.
