1. Multiply Maintenance Payor's Income by 30% 2. Multiply Maintenance Payee's Income by 20% Subtract Line 2 from Line 1 = Result 1 Subtract Maintenance Payee's Income from 40% of Combined Income* = Result 2 Enter the lower of Result 2 or Result 1, but if less than or equal to zero, enter zero. THIS IS THE CALCULATED GUIDELINE AMOUNT OF MAINTENANCE WITH THE HIGHER FORMULA. * Combined Income equals Maintenance Payor's Income up to \$203,000 plus Maintenance Payee's Income.
