Job Description: Private Hunting Club Farm Manager

Position Overview:

Responsibilities:

Farming:

- Coordinating and purchasing seed, fertilizer, lime, and spraying chemicals from local suppliers.
- Coordinating soil testing for appropriate fertilizer.
- Prepare fields for planting, which includes, but is not limited to tilling and discing fields, planting, spraying, and irrigating if necessary.
- Coordinating cutting corn for silage or contracting it out to another farmer. We have historical done both.

Hunting Season:

- Harvest corn in a very specific manner to enhance our hunting.
- Prepare ponds and blinds for hunting season
- Camo and repair blinds for hunting season.

Infrastructure and Facilities:
