Celebrate the Fourth of July in Everett: Fireworks, live music, great food and family fun!

Come celebrate Everett's July Fourth at Legion Memorial Park and enjoy live music, food trucks, a beer garden and fun for the whole family. The festival starts at 3 p.m. and ends after the fireworks (about 10:30 p.m.).

Ride the shuttle!

Heads up, there's NO PARKING at Legion Memorial Park on the Fourth of July. Everett Transit will be providing FREE shuttle service to and from Legion Memorial Park from Everett Community College. It drops people off at the north end of Legion Memorial Park. When you're ready to leave the festival, take the free shuttle back to your car

at the College.

The shuttle starts running at 3 p.m. and continues until the fireworks are over.

The Fireworks Show will start around 10 p.m.

Live music is back for the Celebration! Here's the lineup for this year's Fourth of July:

- Small Paul: 5 - 6 p.m. (R&B, Pop, Rock, Vintage)

- The Jaws of Brooklyn: 6:30 - 7:30 p.m. (Soul-inspired Rock)

- Eden: 8 - 10 p.m. (Blues, Rock & Pop)

Food trucks! Food trucks! Food trucks! Don't fill up on hotdogs and potato salad before getting to the festival because you're going to want

to save room for the food trucks. There will be over a dozen food truck options—something for everyone!

The Thunder on the Bay is Snohomish County's largest fireworks show. And there's no better place to watch than Legion Park!

Everett Music Initiative will host their annual beer garden with tasty local beverages for anyone 21+. The beer garden is by the music stage so you can watch the music while you imbibe.

There's plenty for the kids to do, too!

Imagine Children's Museum will be at the festival with fun kid-friendly activities.

Legion Memorial Park also has a great playground and ball fields. Have a lawn game the kids love? Bring it!

The event is free to attend.

Dogs are allowed but must remain on their leashes. If bringing your dog on the shuttle, they need to wear a muzzle unless they're a service animal. If your pet is afraid of fireworks, please leave them in the safety of their own home.

If you wish, bring low back chairs so you don't block the view of the fireworks from the people behind you.

There will be a water fountain station that you can use to fill up your water bottles.

Music at the Marina is the perfect pairing of stunning marina views and a variety of local music.

Head down to Port Gardner Landing at the Port of Everett on Thursday evenings, from 5-9 p.m. July 13, 20, 27, August 3, 10, 17, 24, and 31 to enjoy music at the pier, plus a beer garden and food trucks.
