## Enjoy Music at the Marina

## Summertime fun on Jetty Island

The summer long Jetty Island Days runs July 5 through Labor Day with ferry transportation to and from the Jetty.

Jetty Island, located 1/4 mile off of the Everett waterfront, is a man-made island with a two mile long sandy beach and shallow warm water that is a kite boarder's paradise.

This hidden waterfront gem offers the longest sandy beach in the Puget Sound with an untouched natural beauty - a rarity in the Pacific Northwest.

The two miles of continuous sandy beach is unique to the area and is ideal for sunbathing, picnicking and observing nature and other outdoor activities.

The island is accessible by personal watercraft all year long, but during the summer you can catch the Jetty ferry.

The Jetty ferry departs from the 10th Street Boat Launch and Marine Park Wednesday-Sunday throughout the summer.

New to the Jetty Island program is an online reservation system for island-goers to secure their spot on the ferry in advance. Previously ferry transport was available on a first come, first-served basis, with no assurance of catching a ride. The new reservation system will reduce crowding at the ferry landing and help track the number of people on the ferry. It will also help avoid early closures on nice days when Jetty

Island can reach its maximum capacity.

The cost for providing transportation of the ferry will be partially offset by a nominal passenger fee of \$3 per person, children age two
